Regulating Licensing Bodies

Definition & Function of the Licensing Body

Licensing Body which fails to meet its obligation after being declared will be revoked

Government will monitor the Licensing Body's activities to promote Transparency, Accountability & Good Governance

Operation without declaration as licensing body is an offence – sentence not more RM500,000 (USD 125,000)

New business model



Amendment to existing provisions relates to licensing body

SECTION 27A, LICENSING BODY COPYRIGHT ACT 1987

COMPLIANCE

27A (2)

An **application** for a declaration shall be made in such form and on such medium as the **Controller may determine** which shall contain the following information:

(a) The applicant's **constituent document**, which has as its **main object**, or one of its main objects, **the negotiation or granting**, either as owner or prospective owner of copyright or as agent for him, of copyright licences, and whose objects also include the granting of licences covering works of more than one author; and

(b) The list of copyright owners or their agents who are **members of the applicant**.

27A (3)

Upon **receipt of an application**, the **Controller may declare an applicant to be a licensing body** and issue a declaration in writing to that effect to the said applicant.

27A (4)

Notwithstanding subsection (3), the **Controller** shall **refuse** an application if **the information** provided by the applicant pursuant to subsection (2) **is insufficient or unsatisfactory** to show that the applicant is **fit and proper to be a licensing body**.

27A (5)


AFTER DECLARATION

The licensing body shall provide the Controller with a **copy of its profit and loss account, balance sheet** and **auditor's report** which are **tabled at the licensing body's annual general meeting** not later than **one month** after the date of the annual general meeting.

MULTIPLE COLLECTION BODY

PROS

- Maintain Previous Status Quo**
- No Additional Layer**
- Individual Body Autonomy**
- Less Trust Issues**
- Less Back-End Issues**

CONS

- Inconvenience/Confusion for Users**
- Multiple Tariffs**
- Replicated Collections Costs**
- Poorer Market Coverage**

PROBLEMS – ISSUES – RESOLUTION

- ❑ Unsatisfied CMOs members - unclear on membership due to two CMOs covering on performers
- ❑ Unsatisfied Users - tariff scheme imposed... e.g. use of music/songs at village wedding festive
- ❑ Unresolved dissatisfaction between CMOs - RPM v PRISM
- ❑ Distribution & royalty issues among CMOs
- ❑ Way forward and resolution by Task Force on CMOs concerning collection of royalties issue;
- ❑ Government way forward approach based on Task Force's findings & report.
